6th class had a great time at a recent tag rugby blitz in New Ross. The girls and boys dazzled and weren't beaten in any of their games.


#### **Sing Out Loud**

Unfortunately, as you all know we have had a poor experience dealing with Bodibro for our new school uniform. A number of uniforms have still not arrived however they will in the coming days and weeks I am told. I can only apologise that this process has not been smoother. I have attached the most recent email that was sent from Bodibro;

Hi,

Most of you should have received your school uniform from us by now. We understand that none of you have had a positive experience over the past couple of months, and we would like to apologise again for this.

As you're aware from Ben's previous emails, we used a second supplier for our primary school uniform shops to alleviate some pressure from school shop orders. Unfortunately, this resulted in more pressure on us, as the second supplier wasn't equipped to handle the volume of orders we needed to fulfill. This ultimately led to the delays you've all faced.

This week, we received all these orders from the supplier and have been working around the clock to bag and pack them. Unfortunately, we've noticed a decline in the quality of the quarter zip top from this supplier. There are issues with crest quality, sleeve length, and overall the quality doesn't meet our standards or what we want associated with our brand.

In light of this, we want to let you all know that we'll be replacing all these quarter zips. We made this decision with our customers at the forefront of our minds. We understand the costs you've incurred to purchase from us, and the last thing we want is for the product to be subpar. We pride ourselves on quality and are deeply disappointed to find ourselves in this situation. Ultimately, our commitment to quality is something we stand by, and we want to correct this situation.

If you've already received your quarter zip top, or if you receive it in the coming days, you don't need to do anything. We'll handle this from here and reorder all quarter zips from our sportswear supplier. We're confident that when you receive these replacement tops in approximately 4 weeks, you'll be satisfied with them.

Once again, we want to apologise for all the hardship, inconvenience, and the overall negative experience you've

had with us. We hope you'll have an open mind and allow us to rebuild some of the trust and confidence you may have lost in us. We will be in touch once these replacement tops are ready.

We thank you for your patience and understanding at this time.
